A24. WDC has not encountered any yet. Quote >50% solids

Q25. Would WDC consider a permanent trailer onsite, which would be swapped when pickup is requested?

A25. No

Q26. Will any of the waste descriptions carry the Army 'X' waste classification codes, i.e. 3X, or 4X? If so, please identify those Line Items and waste description.

A26. No they will not carry a 3X or 4X designation.

Q27. How have these 3X / 4X streams been treated / processed to be determined 'agent free'.

A27. NA

Q28. Due to the added requirements / restrictions needed for shipment and receipt of 3X / 4X waste, could WDC add Waste Category line item(s) in the Pricing Schedule for these Waste Descriptions?

A28. NA

Q29. Will the Supplier be required to provide a chemist for non-bulk shipments to package lab-pack containers or will these be pre-packaged?

A29. No chemist required, they will be prepackaged

Q30. Will WDC approve a 10-day transfer facility so that waste can be off-loaded and transferred onto other transport vehicles for deliver to WDC-approved TSDF(s)?

If these are truly 'Bulk' tanker loads, please add a line item on the pricing schedule for 'Tanker Truck – Trip Charge'.

A31. Bulk is considered to be anything greater than 119 gallons.

007g has been added to the pricing sheet for tanker trip charges

Q32. Pricing Schedule: Universal Waste 004a – 004h, these fine waste descriptions are many time packaged in less than drum (55DM) load quantities or packaged in boxes or pallets. The unit of measure 'drum' is many times not applicable. Please consider changing the UOM for this category to a per 'pound' unit of measure.

A32. Unit of Measure has been changed to pound on the pricing sheet

Q33. Pricing Schedule: Incineration Line Items 002a – 002f are very broad categories that can encompass everything from easily treatable waste to extremely hazardous, hard to handle reactives. In
